



Education Mini Grants - Supplies

Support for environmental education

Do you have an idea for a lesson plan or activity involving water resources or the environment? The watershed district is offering mini grants to help cover the cost of the materials and support your ideas. Grant awards range from \$250 to \$500 and are available to teachers and informal educators. Applications are accepted throughout the year until funds run out.

Criteria

- Schools must be located within watershed district boundaries.
- Supplies must have a water resources, environmental or science component.
- Applicant is eligible for one grant award per academic year.

Awards

- Amount: \$250 - \$500
- Grants are awarded as a rebate for purchases made.
- A project report and receipts must be provided for refund to be issued.

How it works

1. Come up with an idea!
2. Submit a request to the District including: items you would like to purchase, how the purchase relates to water resources or the environment, and an estimate of the costs.
3. You should hear from someone within 15 business days if your application is approved.
4. Submit your receipt along with some photos for our records.
5. A reimbursement check will come in the mail.
