Data Collection and Monitoring Project: DCM-01

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN that the Pelican River Watershed District Board of Managers will hold a public hearing at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, July 15, 2021 at the District office located at 211 Holmes Street West, Wells-Fargo Bank Building (conference room-second floor), Detroit Lakes, MN 56501 to receive public comment on the establishment and ordering of a District-wide Data Collection and Monitoring Project, Project Number DCM-01, pursuant to MN State Statute 103D.605.

The Project will facilitate District-wide water quality monitoring and assessment, data collection, research, and studies within the waters of the Pelican River Watershed District, including education and public outreach activities.

The Data Collection and Monitoring Project Engineer's Report/Project Plan prepared by Stantec, is on file at the District's office located at 211 Holmes Street West, Wells-Fargo Building, Suite 201, Detroit Lakes, MN 56501 or can be viewed on the District's website: www.prwd.org.

The Project will be funded by an ad valorem levy of a tax pursuant to 103D.905 Subd 3, not to exceed 0.00798 percent of the taxable market value for a period not to exceed 15 consecutive years. The engineer's report estimates an annual maximum project cost of \$169,759, depending on work performed.

All parties interested in the project are to appear before the Managers at the time and place stated above to show why the Managers should not find that the project will be conducive to public health, promote the general welfare, be in compliance with the watershed management plan and the provisions of Minnesota Statutes chapter 103D, and order that the project be established.
