1. How often should we assume, based on your records, pickup at designated "sporadic" sites - 1x or 2x a month?

A. The roadside pickup occurs on a weekly basis with driving around the lake and picking up the aquatic vegetation piles. On the maps, the red areas will usually have piles out each week. The areas delineated as "Sporadic" means piles may not be present every week – it could be 5 weeks in a row and then nothing for 2 weeks, and then 4 weeks with piles – you just never know. Other areas not marked MAY HAVE piles, depending upon weather/season conditions, but not usually.

2. How has the plant waste been disposed of in the past?

Lakeview Township has a designated compost area within their general compost site near Mill Pond. You will have to contact Lakeview Twp Supervisors (Phil Hansen is who manages the compost site).

3. Is any transport permitting or management of the waste necessary?

A MN DNR Prohibited Invasive Species permit is required to transport and dispose of AIS - you can fill out the permit application on their website – fairly straightforward.
